# WAHA – Medical Transportation 2020 Summer Boat Transportation Schedule

Effective: Wednesday, June 17, 2020 - 3rd Revision

Boat Transporation services to and from Weeneebayko General Hospital (WGH) are provided for Non-insured Health Benefits (NIHB) program patients and their escorts, Weeneebayko Area Health Authority (WAHA) business travelers and non-status patients attending appointments.

New info: COVID19 Screening for all Passengers – Limited to 5 Passengers/boat run.

### **MOOSONEE PASSENGERS:**

Prior to boarding boat, you must:

- Be screened by a WAHA Medical Transportation Driver
- Sign Passenger Screening Questionnaire form
- Put on mask provided by Driver

#### MOOSE FACTORY PASSENGERS:

Prior to boarding boat, you must:

- Be screened see Screener in the Emergency Department at WGH
- Sign Passenger Screening Questionnaire form and deliver signed form to WAHA Driver.
- WAHA Driver to provide signed form to Natasha Aina, RN Manager, Occupational Health, Safety and Wellness -WGH
- Put on mask provided by driver

## **CHARTER:**

\*\*Clients/escorts traveling on flight 704 to Kingston must be at Liaison no later than 12:30 p.m. (for screening) and must check in at Air Creebec no later than 2 p.m. for 3:00 p.m. departure.

\*\*Physician's/Visiting Specialists/WAHA Business Travelers must be at Liaison on or before 2:00 p.m. for 2:15 p.m. boat run.

All passengers must provide a valid ID to the ticket agent upon check in.

#### Remember:

- The boat runs on time and will not be delayed for someone running late.
- There is a limited number of seats. Children without scheduled appointments cannot accompany clients (parents).
- No pets, alcohol or illegal substances are allowed.

## **Travel Warrants:**

- All travelers must present a Travel Warrant to the driver.
- WAHA staff and business travelers must email their travel warrant at least two days in advance to WAHA-local-drivers@waha.ca

## Bags, luggage and parcels:

- Only one (1) carry-on and one (1) piece of luggage weighing no more than 25 pounds is allowed. Exception for client's medical equipment.
- Passengers are responsible for making alternate transportation arrangements for any extra bags/parcels weighing over 25 pounds (excluding business travelers who require tools to perform their job).
