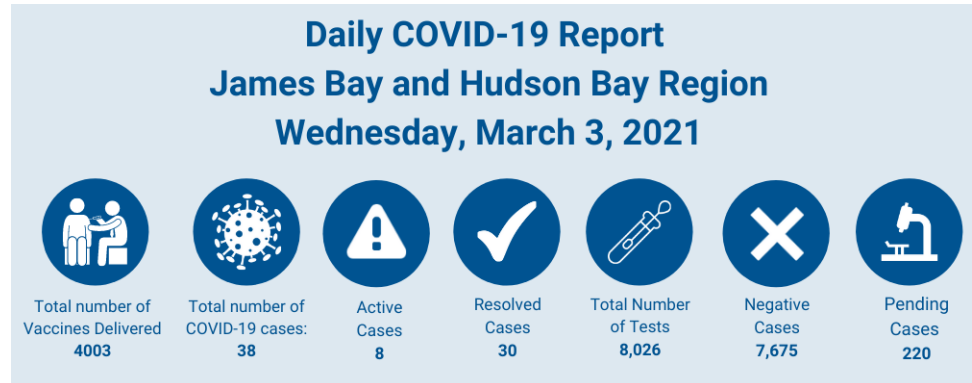

- Community Vaccine Clinics:
 - COVID-19 vaccination clinics for the second dose are scheduled in Attawapiskat for Thursday, March 4th and Friday, March 5th and on Monday, March 8th. The vaccinations are taking place in Kattawapiskak Elementary School from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Individuals who receive their first dose will follow up with the public health office in their community to receive their second dose.
 - COVID-19 mass vaccination clinics are scheduled in Kashechewan for March 1-3 from 10am-4pm in the High School Gym. Please bring proof of first dose and your health card. The clinics are for adults 18 years of age and older.
