The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine is used to prevent COVID-19 and approved for youth aged 12-17 years old.

Over the next several weeks, Pfizer vaccine clinics will be set up in communities throughout the region to deliver the first and second dose of the vaccine

The mass vaccination clinics are tentatively scheduled on:

Fort Albany: June 4 & 10, 2021

Second Dose: TBA

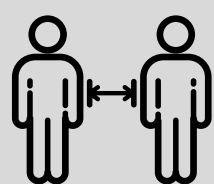
While the vaccine is voluntary, it is an important opportunity to protect oneself and others from COVID-19.
