## **High Risk Potential Exposure to COVID-19**

Issued: April 6th, 2022

Weeneebayko Area Health Authority is advising the public of a potential high risk public exposure to COVID-19 related to the following travel:

 Monday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 – Ontario Northland Polar Bear Express Train, Coach 2 from Cochrane to Moosonee departing from Cochrane at 9:00 am.

Individuals on the train in Coach 2 that live, work or are visiting a First Nations community within the James Bay and Hudson Bay Region or in Moosonee need to:

- Stay home and self-isolate for 5 days (unless your community has different COVID-19 isolation protocols), even if you are vaccinated, and
- arrange COVID-19 testing, especially if you develop symptoms.

If you develop symptoms while isolating, tell the people you live with to isolate as well.
