## **High Risk Potential Exposure to COVID-19**

Issued: April 24th, 2022

Weeneebayko Area Health Authority is advising the public of a potential high risk public exposure to COVID-19 related to the following travel:

 Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 – Air Creebec Flight #871, from Timmins to Kashechewan with stops in Moosonee, Attawapiskat, and Fort Albany. The flight departed from Timmins at 10:00 am.

Individuals on the flight that live, work or are visiting a First Nations community within the James Bay and Hudson Bay Region or in Moosonee need to:

• Stay home and self-isolate for 5 days (unless your community has different COVID-19 isolation protocols), especially if you develop symptoms.

If you develop symptoms while isolating, tell the people you live with to isolate as well.
