## **High Risk Potential Exposure to COVID-19**

Issued: July 12, 2022

Weeneebayko Area Health Authority is advising the public of a potential high risk public exposure to COVID-19 related to the following travel:

- Monday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Air Creebec Flight from Attawapiskat to Timmins, departing from Attawapiskat at 1:30 pm.
- Friday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Air Creebec Flight from Timmins to Attawapiskat, departing Timmins at 10:00 am.

Individuals on the flight that live, work or are visiting a First Nations community within the James Bay and Hudson Bay Region or in Moosonee need to:

- A) Self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days
- B) If you develop symptoms, arrange COVID-19 testing, and self-isolate immediately and
- C) Follow the public health direction from the community in which you reside.
